2019 Bond Financial Update

2019 Bond Program: \$267,000,000 allocated for new facilities and district wide improvements. Total w/carryover from 2014 will be \$291,297,000.

January 2023 - Total P.O.'s issued: \$208,794,411 & 70.32% completed or in progress

 - Hopper Field Entry and Ticket Booth Improvements
 - New Field Lighting (handled by maintenance dept)
 - Walkway from Parking Area with Lighting
 - Drainage and Lighting Improvements Under the Bleachers

SFA History & Update

2014 Bond Allocation \$6.3 million - Actual Spent \$342,375

- Add 8 classrooms, eliminate detached buildings
- Add Gymnasium
- Upgrade Library to Media Center
- New Windows
- Kitchen upgrades
- Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing Improvements
- Update Interior Finishes

2019 Bond Planning \$18.8 million - Actual Spent \$949,682

- New SFA Elementary Replacement Campus
 - Sterling Construction:
 - VLK Design Launch-July 23, 2019
 - Bid March 2020-Pandemic GMP \$5 million
 - Drymalla Construction:
 - Bid/GMP April 2021; federal floodplain changes discovered (\$3.5 million over)
 - Elevate Building and mitigate per floodplain requirements +1.5 million
 - Redesign to a more compact 3 story +\$2.1 million
 - Raise building on piles +\$2.9 million
 - Renovate/Maintain Existing Building
 - Exploring New Property Construction costs today estimated at \$27.6 million (\$10 million over budget)
 - Improvements to Maintain Current Campus (limited under floodplain requirements)
 - No plans to close the campus
 - Did not flood during Harvey
 - Insurance vs FEMA
