- Schedules that students are receiving today are tentative, as counselors continue to balance classes and match services needed. Counselors will make every attempt to keep students on the same team with the same teachers, although the order of classes may need to be changed.


How to Log on to your Chromebook



Once you turn on your Chromebook, you will be asked to enter your username/email address.

The student email address is:

You will need your student ID to reset or change your password, and your student ID is located under your name on your printed schedule. This is your lunch number.

Now you will be prompted to enter your password.

 Please try entering that same password.
 - 5th Grade Password is set to the Student ID/Lunch number.
 - 6th Grade Passwords were created by the individual during the 2019-2020 school year and remain the same.
- If you tried to enter your password 2 times and it still does not work, or you do not remember your password, please visit the <u>Password</u> <u>Reset Portal directions</u> located on your screen.

How to Access Google Classroom




On <u>BISD Connect Jr.</u> Click the Google Classroom symbol.




When you log into Google Classroom, you may see that you've been invited to classes. These should correspond with your schedule.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

In anticipation of a greater number of students being car riders and an effort to increase the efficiency of the arrival and dismissal process, we are making some changes to our procedures. Please review the information below as well as the attached diagram.

Arrival

- The car rider line will be on the side of the building by the gyms and cafeteria, and the students will enter the building through the glass doors.
- We will continue with NO left turn from Lake Rd. into the parking lot. Rasco staff will be the exception for AM left turns.
- Bus riders will be unloaded at the front entrance and enter the building through the front doors.
- Prior to entering the building, each student will need to put on a mask.
- At 7:30, cafeteria staff will begin serving breakfast.
- Any student who is eating breakfast will remain in the cafeteria until they are done eating. Any students who are not eating breakfast will report to the appropriate gym for their grade level where they will line up according to their first period teacher. We will have staff helping direct the students to their appropriate locations.

Dismissal

Car Riders

- We will continue with NO left turn from Lake Rd. into the parking lot.
- Parents will pick up their student in the same manner as the drop off, by entering the parking lot on the cafeteria/gym side.
- Each student will receive a car rider tag with a number assigned to them.
- We ask that you make sure that whoever is picking your child up has this tag displayed in their vehicle. If this tag is lost or if you need
 additional tags, contact the front office.
- All car riders will wait in the gym until their number is called.
- Staff will call for 10-15 students at a time, release the cars, and then call for the next group of students.
- All cars will need to turn right out of the parking lot for student safety and traffic flow.
- We hope this new procedure helps to not only expedite the process but also protect students from the rain or heat.

Walkers

• Walkers will be released first. They can either exit to the right and walk to the crossing guard at the stoplight or walk across the street with a Rasco staff member at the crosswalk.

Bus Riders

- Students who have registered for the bus and have been assigned a bus number will line up by their bus number inside the front hallway.
- All students must wear a mask when riding the bus and utilize hand sanitizer as they enter and exit the bus.

We recognize this is a new process, and we anticipate a learning curve, so we ask you in advance for your support and patience. Please know student safety and efficiency are our ultimate goals for arrival and dismissal.
